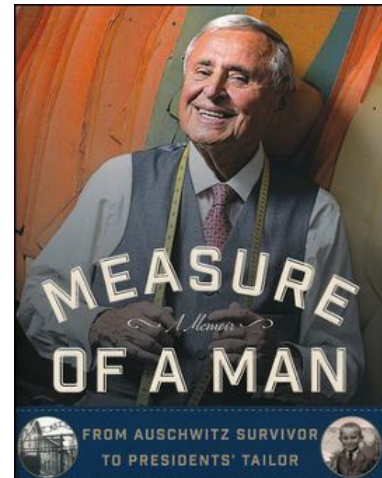

Holocaust survivor Martin Greenfield has been called “America’s greatest living tailor.”

The first time he took up a needle and thread was in Auschwitz to repair the shirt of the SS guard who had beaten him. He emigrated from the former Czechoslovakia to the United States in 1947, and today he is considered one of America’s most respected and accomplished tailors – the man who has dressed presidents and movie stars, including Paul Newman and Leonardo DiCaprio, President Dwight Eisenhower and President Barack Obama. Mr. Greenfield will discuss his life journey, as recently set forth in his poignant memoir *Measure of a Man: From Auschwitz Survivor to Presidents’ Tailor*.
