

Selection of Student Council Delegates

The Temple Emanu-El Religious School Student Council consists of student delegates from grades 4 – 7, from both Sunday and Monday classes.

Delegates meet four times over the fall semester, on Sunday mornings at 9:00 AM, prior to regular class sessions. Specific dates are on the reverse side of this letter.

As a representative organization, the Council acts as a voice of student opinion and has a major responsibility for the selection of Tzedakah beneficiaries for the school. This year, veteran religious school teacher Mark Willner returns as the Faculty Advisor.

Every history class in grades 4 – 6 and the students in Mitzvah Corps should be represented by at least two delegates, if possible. It is also appropriate to allow more students from your class to participate, if they are able to make the commitment.
