A unique contribution to Temple Emanu-El's social history:

- **Wedding dress of Helen Krass Popper
Donated by Mrs. Popper's children,
Jane Zorek and John Popper**

The daughter of Eda and Nathan Krass (Rabbi at Temple Emanu-El from 1923 through 1949), Helen Krass married Edward Popper on Valentine's Day 1929, in one of the major social events of that year.

"They said that more hearts were broken at that wedding than ever before because of all the women who wanted Daddy and all the men who

wanted my mother," Mrs. Zorek said. "Also, no one thought the marriage was going to last because she was so young, but they were together for more than 50 years."
