S'u Sh'arim (Psalm 24:9-10) Lift up your heads, O gates! Lift yourselves up, O ancient doors! Let the King of Glory enter. Who is this King of Glory? The Lord of Hosts – He is the King of Glory

Ono B'choiach (Liturgy) By the great power of Your right hand, O set the captive free. Revered God, accept Your people's prayer: strengthen us, cleanse us. Almighty God, guard as the apple of Your eye those who seek You. Bless them, cleanse them, pity them; ever grant them Your truth.

Shachar Avakeshcha (Liturgy) Early will I seek You, God my refuge strong; Late prepare to meet You with my evening song. What this frail heart's dreaming, and my tongue's poor speech, can they even distant to Your greatness reach? Being great in mercy, You will not despise praises which till death's hour from my soul will rise.

Lo V'chayil (Zechariah 4:6) Not by might nor by power but My spirit, saith the Lord of Hosts.

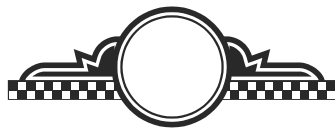
V'sham'ru (Ex 31:16-17) The Israelite people shall keep the Sabbath, observing the Sabbath throughout the ages as a covenant for all time: it shall be a sign for all time between Me and the people of Israel. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day He ceased from work and was refreshed.

Ozi V'zimrat Yah (Bitziniot Nov II/III, Exodus 15:2) The Lord is my strength and might; He is become my deliverance. This is my God and I will enshrine Him; The God of my father, and I will exalt Him.

Mi Chamocha (Exodus 15:11, 18, liturgy) Who is like You, Eternal One, among the gods that are worshipped? Who is like You, majestic in holiness, awesome in splendor, doing wonders? In their escape from the sea, Your children saw Your sovereign might displayed. “This is my God” they cried. “The Eternal will reign for ever and ever”.

Oseh Shalom (Liturgy) May He who causes peace to reign in the high heavens let peace descend on us, on all Israel, and all the world.
