Is New York a Future Detroit?

With over 40 years' experience negotiating on behalf of municipal agencies and serving in key financial posts, the **Hon. Richard Ravitch** sees the stress on our cities from an insider's perspective. He will discuss our city's financial crisis and what he views as our prospects, as well as provide a call-to-action.

Mr. Ravitch entered politics in the 1960s after law school and the Army. In 1975, he brokered the rescue of New York City from near-certain financial collapse. He has been chairman of the New York Urban Development Corporation, chairman of the MTA, chairman of the Bowery Savings Bank, and lieutenant governor of New York. He recently served as court-appointed consultant in Detroit's bankruptcy. He describes his life's work in his 2014 book, *So Much to Do*. Copies of his book will be available.
